Nonalcoholic Fatty Liver Disease, or NAFLD, studies present unique enrollment challenges that Pro-ficiency directly addresses.

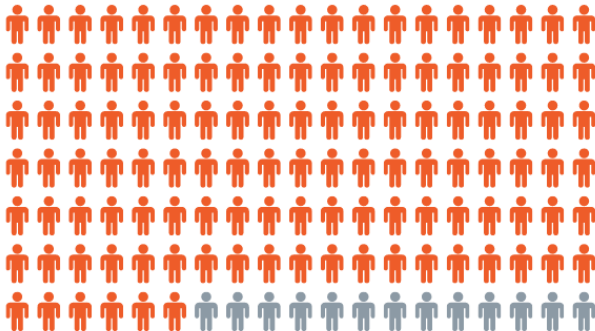
